2019 AMENDED RULES 9/10 BOYS

- 1. All games will be played in accordance with (A) 2019 Official Baseball Rulebook (B) the following amended rules. CYB will follow State Safety and PONY guidelines in regards to bats used, pitching rules, code of conduct, and concussion protocols.
- 2. The base path for this division will be 65' with the pitching mound at 46' And a game time of 1 hour 45 minutes.
- 3. A bat with a barrel size of 2 ¼" or 2 5/8" diameter can be used. Any bat used must have the USA approved sticker or stamp.
- 4. Each team must have at least seven (7) players for the game to begin once lineup have been exchanged by coaches and the first pitch of the game is thrown, any additional player arriving late will be added to the bottom batting order.
- **5.** Everyone will bat in continuous order. (ENTIRE ROSTER). If a player leaves the game before completion of the game for any reason other than ejection, they will not be called out, but they cannot return to the game. **Ten players on the field (Extra Outfielder)**
- 6. All players will play at least three innings in a six inning game and all players will play on defense every other inning. A player cannot sit out on defense for more than 1 inning at a time, (except for disciplinary actions that must be approved by the HUIC, or a commissioner.) or if he/she is injured or chooses not to play.
- 7. The umpires will determine who the head coach is prior to each game. Only the head coach displaying his/her badge can dispute a call during the game. The rulebook or amended rules must be in coach's possession (no rule book-no discussion). If the head coach doesn't have his/her badge the assistant coach be designated as the head coach for this game. Judgment calls cannot be disputed.
- 8. If all coaches do not have their badges, they have 5 minutes to find a board member to stand in for the head coach. If no board member can be found, then the game will be forfeited by that team but the game will be played for the kids' sake without umpires.
- 9. Home team will be determined by coin flip prior to game. Home team must have a scorebook, if not then other team will be home team.
 - a. Home team will maintain official scorebook, insure sponsor names are on the score sheet. They will also maintain official pitch count in case of disputes.
 - b. Both teams will maintain a pitch count sheet for all pitchers. At the end of the game they will tally the amount for each pitcher and sign, and turn it in to umpire.

- 10. Both teams will report runs to the umpire each half inning. Umpires will maintain the game score card.
- 11. No infield before the game, players may warm up in the outfield and they may take grounders on the foul sideline.
- 12. A batter is automatically out if the bat is thrown, on the second offense. (One warning per team).
- 13. There will be one offensive timeout per inning (TOTAL) to talk to batters. There will be one defensive timeout per inning. On the second defensive time out, the pitcher must be removed.
- 14. The batter and all base runners must wear helmets with chinstraps. Helmets purchased by parents must also provide chin straps. Teams will be issued only 5 chin straps. Metal cleats are not allowed.
- 15. A game is six (6) innings. However, an official game is 5 innings. no new inning will begin after an hour and forty minutes. If a game is tied after six (6) innings, additional innings can be played up to (but not exceeding the time limit). If the game is tied after six innings the international tie breaker rule will be used, last batted out goes to 2nd no outs, However, a game can end in a tie, and ties will count in the standings.
- 16. Games ended by inclement weather, or other reasons beyond league control (lights out, rain etc.) prior to the time limit, will be considered official after 5 innings or 41/2 inning if the home team is in the lead. If a game is stopped prior to it being considered official, it will be played over from the beginning as a new game.
- 17. A maximum of five (5) runs per inning will be in effect. However, the sixth inning will be an open inning with no run limitation.
- 18. Hurry up rule will be in effect meaning that the catcher can be replaced by a pinch runner with two (2) outs in the inning. The pinch runner will be the last BATTED out of the inning. If another runner is used, and a pitch is thrown, then the runner will be called out & inning ended. It is the batting team's responsibility to make sure the correct player is used as the pinch runner. The opposing team must inform the umpire of the error during that inning. If the defensive team does not catch the mistake till later in game, the outcome of that inning stands.
- 19. Leading off is allowed. Balks will be called and explained to the kids in the first ½ half of the season. Runners can steal one (1) base at a time. Drop 3rd strike is in effect.

Second ½ of season (May 1st) balks will be enforced. If a balk is called the play is dead. Bunting is allowed

- 20. No intentional contact (during close play), with a base runner will be allowed. Instigator can be called out, or thrown out. The call may be reversed at the discretion of the umpire.
- 21. Pitchers will be allowed to pitch to the maximum allowed by the pitch count rule. A pitcher that hits a batter twice (2) in one inning, or three times in a game may be removed from the mound at the discretion of the umpire.
 - a) No spot pitching will be allowed, once a pitcher is replaced by another pitcher, he cannot return to pitch in the same game.
 - b) Coaches will maintain pitch count per inning and confirm with opposing coach if there is a discrepancy then the score book will be utilized to determine correct count.
- 22. A maximum of five (5) pitches will be allowed between innings. When changing pitchers, 8 pitches maximum will be allowed.
- 23. Infield fly rule will not be in effect.
- 24. A 10 run slaughter rule will be in effect after 5 innings or 41/2 if home team is leading.
- 25. If a coach is ejected from the game for any reason, that coach will sit out the rest of that game and will have a choice to either, not be allowed to coach in their next scheduled game, or pay a \$100. 00 fine.
- 26. If a player is ejected from the game, his position on the batting order will remain vacant and will produce an out every inning his turn at bat comes up. The player must stay in the dugout or leave the facility at the umpire's discretion, and will not be allowed to play his next scheduled game. If more than one player or one parent is ejected, then the head coach will also be ejected. Parents ejected will have to leave the ball park.
- 27. Fake tags on base runners will be considered an obstruction.
- 28. Pitching: No Curve Balls, 1st occurrence team warning, 2nd occurrence warning. Third occurrence the pitcher will be removed, and coach ejected at umpire's discretion.

 This is for the safety of the player.
- 29. No coach is allowed on the baseball field at any time with open toe shoes.
- 30. The head coach or the assistant coach must wear team shirt and badges at all games.

- 31. A base runner cannot steal home, but may advance if a play is attempted at another base or on a passed ball.
- 32. Head first slides are not allowed on any base due to safety reasons. The runner will be called out if he/she does. No questions asked.

- 33. No more than two coaches allowed on field when on offense, all other times coaches will remain in the dugout.
- 34. If a player has to sit out due to injury, then the player will sit out for at least ½ inning for evaluation.
