COACHES RESPONSIBILITIES FOR THE 2019 CERES RECREATIONAL LEAGUE.

1. Anyone wishing to become a coach, assistant coach must fill out form during registration or before draw night.
2. All Coaches (including assistant coaches) selected must attend all meetings or have a team representative.
3. Must show CPR, first aid compliant. Must turn in copy of valid CPR card. Mayers CPR on 4th street.
4. Must show proof of mandated concussion protocol training, on line only. CDC website, print certificate. It takes about 15 minutes.
5. Anyone who has business on the ball field must be finger printed. All coaches, asst. coaches, volunteers etc. Please bring picture ID (driver's license or Ca. ID)
6. Must have CYB issued ID in order to be on field during game. See rules for more information.
7. Must sign code of conduct form. All coaches, parents and players.
8. Must provide email and telephone number which can receive text messages. This is to receive communications from commissioner or league.

Team selection process:

1. Coaches that bring in a sponsor may have up to four pre-selected players (but not more than 2 Blaze players)
2. Must attend tryout day (8U and up) on selected date TBD
3. If try out day is rained out, players will be selected through blind draw.
4. All players must play every other inning. No one sits for more than one inning unless with prior approval.
5. All coaches must attend coach's clinic on designated date and location .

Administration

1. During draw night, fill out roster with uniform size. CYB will pay for two coach's jerseys, it will be the responsibility of the head coach to pay for additional shirts and caps.
2. Must have all parents and players (each parent if player lives at multiple households) read and sign a code of conduct form.
3. If you don't have a sponsor, CYB will select your uniform color and you will be informed of the colors.
4. Once game times and dates are posted there will be no changes.
5. Each team will be selected to either work in the snack bar (6 people per shift) inside or cleanup outside eating area or Sunday whole park clean-up, some teams may be selected for more than one duty day.
6. If inclement weather, check website to determine if games are cancelled and when rescheduled.
7. Fund raiser, day at Modesto Nuts. Date: MAY 10 tickets available through board members.

Game Time

1. If a player gets hit on the head, the concussion protocol will be activated.
2. Games can end in a tie. 9/10 and up there may be a 4 team play off.

3. CYB will provide three 2 1/4" bats per field. Baseball bats with 2 5/8" barrel will be allowed. Bats only with the appropriate USA tag and less than 2 5/8" will be used during recreational league.
4. No metal cleats.
5. When picking up equipment bag, please bring a deposit check for \$100.00. This will be returned at end of season when equipment is turned back in.
6. The home team is the official score keeper and will also keep track of pitch count for teams 9/10 and up
7. If coach wants to protest a game, they must pay a \$100.00 protest fee. This will be returned if protest is won. Coach must inform umpire that the game will continue under protest. Remember only rules may be protested not judgement calls.
8. If player or parent is ejected from game the head coach will also be ejected. If coach is ejected they will have the choice of sitting out the next game or paying an ejection fine of \$100.00

Pitch Count

1. Coaches must keep track of pitches thrown by their own and opposing pitchers.
2. They must exchange the name of each pitcher and the number of pitches thrown per inning for the whole game.
3. They will total the number of pitches per pitcher and must sign each other's form along with the game score card and given to the umpire.
4. The total of pitches thrown must equal the opposing coach's numbers.
5. If a discrepancy is so great that coaches cannot agree, then the official score keeper will count the total number and that number will be final.

End of game

1. Coaches must sign score card and pitch count form
2. Must clean up dugout
