- TOPSoccer is US Youth Soccer's branding for soccer programs for children with disabilities, and is strongly supported by Mass Youth Soccer and ECYSA.
- For example, Mass Youth Soccer does not charge registration fees for TOPS players and is expected to provide free player uniforms for the spring season.
- For fall 2022, ECYSA had TOPSoccer programs operating out of Danvers, North Reading and Wakefield, and it is anticipated that the TOPS program in Lawrence will restart.
- ECYSA seeks to support our existing TOPS programs, to facilitate the sharing of resources and best practices amongst these programs and to encourage and assist with the creation of new ones.
- Looking at the geographic concentration of our existing programs (largely based in the south and west of the ECYSA area), there is definitely room for more programs in other ECYSA geographic areas.

Objectives:
