



VAA Youth Football League Equipment Responsibilities and Turn-In



PLEASE READ

The Valley Athletic Association Youth Football Program provides the unique benefit of providing some very expensive equipment for use by its participants. This privilege comes with the responsibility to take proper care of the equipment, use it only for its intended purpose in league sanctioned activities and return it in at least the condition it was when received.

It is YOUR responsibility to work with your team's Coach to get this equipment returned at seasons end. This process can sometimes be difficult for coaches to coordinate, so your support and assistance will be greatly appreciated.

Your Coach will coordinate with you the proper equipment return date. You must return your equipment to your Coach. There are two (2) acceptable methods for accomplishing this:

1. Your coach can collect the equipment from all players and turn it in at the equipment building on one of the scheduled collection dates once he has verified all of it has been returned. (and confirmed this with his coordinator)
2. Your Coach can meet all players from his team at the Lucy Winton Bell equipment shed and verify the return of all equipment on one of the scheduled collection dates. (and confirmed this with his coordinator)

The post season equipment collection dates will be at the Lucy Winton Bell equipment shed on dates yet to be established
